Arriving by car

The HellermannTyton building is within close distance of the M1, A45, M40 and A14. The HellermannTyton building has dedicated staff and visitor parking bays outside the front of the building. Here you will also find wider disabled and assisted parking bays and charging points for electric cars.

Arriving by bus

National and regional coach services operate to Northgate Bus Station, located in Northampton town centre.

There are regular bus services running from the Town Centre or Northampton Railway Station (on Black Lion Hill) to the Claret Car Park bus stop outside HellermannTyton. **Stagecoach Bus service 50** makes 12 to 14 journeys each way during the day.

Alternatively **Uno Bus services 19 and 19b** return to Northampton Train Station and Town Centre every 12-15 minutes.

If you don't mind a short 0.5 mile walk, many buses stop at the St James End, opposite Byfield Road Bus Stop and its a 10 minute walk from there to HellermannTyton.



Arriving by bike

If you choose to arrive by bike, we have facilities on site to enable you to store your bike and equipment and have a shower to freshen up.

There are many excellent cycle routes around Northampton. The HellermannTyton building is accessible by a cycle path with all weather surface.

Ways Through Waterside (route 536) Cycle Route is a purpose built 3 mile track that runs from Brackmills to Sixfields, behind the HellermannTyton building.

Arriving by foot

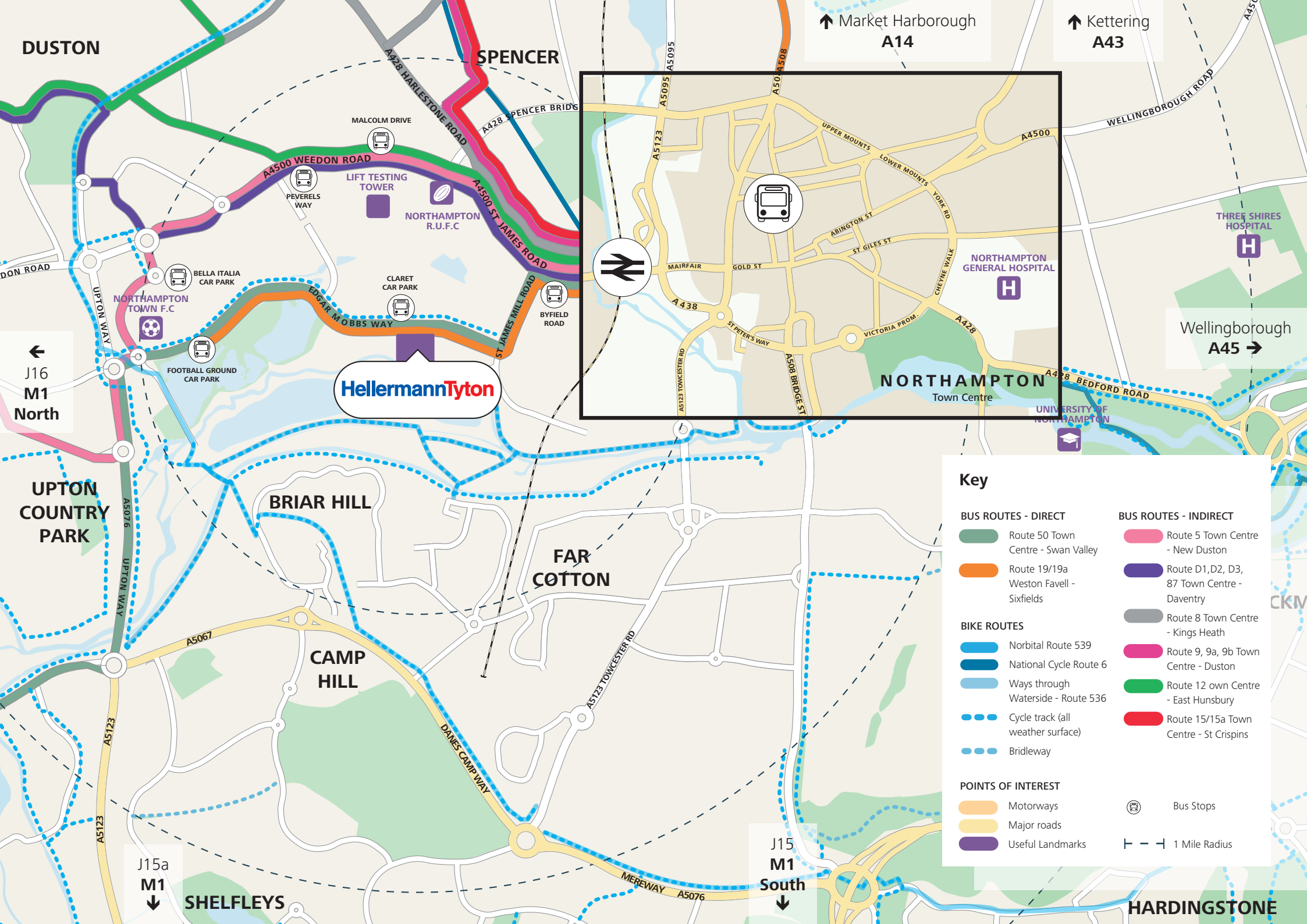
HellermannTyton is within easy walking distance (less than 1 mile) of Northampton Town Centre, Train Station and Sixfields stadium.



Arriving by train

Northampton Train Station is 0.9 miles from HellermannTyton.

This is the East Midlands line that runs from London Euston to Birmingham New Street. The station is 15 minutes walking distance from our building, a short taxi or bus journey.

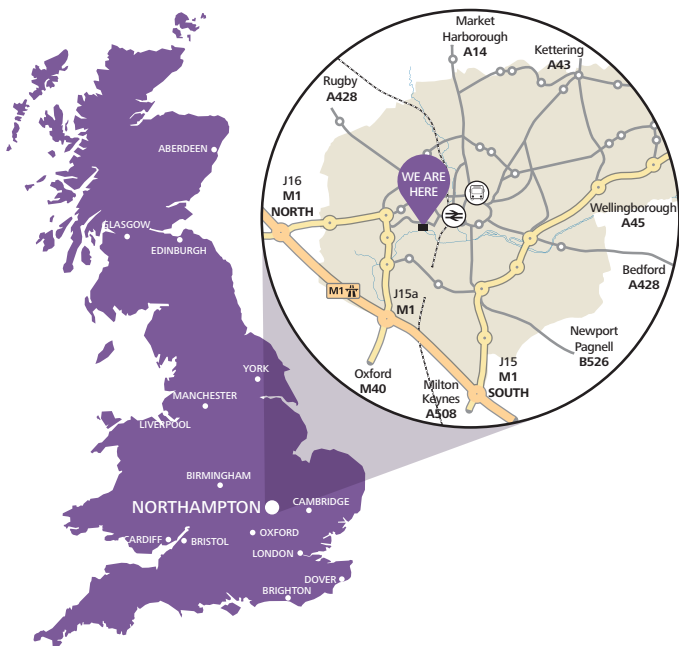
