Information

The 1 day course is split into two main sections a theoretical session followed by a practical session. During the theoretical part of the course the attendee's will cover main areas within the deployment and testing of networking infrastructure these include (but not limited to):

- Specification Responsibilities
- Relevant standards and where these come from
- Structured Cabling Configurations and topologies
- Measuring Cabling Performance
- Consolidation Points
- Health and Safety
- Administration
- Installation Practices
- Shielded Systems
- Power and data separation
- Installation practices and processes
- Testing

In the second session of the course the attendee's will move to our practical training area which enables each to install cables, terminate and then test them. As part of this the trainer will, where appropriate offer suggestions and guidance on common issues found and how to prevent them.

The links will then be tested to the relevant standards to ensure they meet the performance criteria. Time is also spent looking at ways to use the tester to help identify potential issues and how to rectify them.

Finally: There is a written test on the topics covered during the day, which is designed to highlight and re-enforce key areas.

On successful completion of the course the attendee will receive a certificate and a unique certified installer number which is required whenever applying for our extended warranty for category 5e and 6 installations.

Attendees of the course are also eligible for 6 BICSI CPD points if registered with BICSI.
